£20 - pays for a two day training course in Bangladesh for 25 people in either disability awareness, social awareness, gender discrimination, or human rights.



£30 - in Zambia, would buy a child a pair of glasses. This means that they can go to school, and have the best possible chance of a full education. This money also means that disabled organisations can buy three pairs of crutches to enable farmers to get out into the fields, and can be used as a deposit for a person to set up a small market stall.

£149 - business start-up costs for a group running a bicycle repair business in Uganda

£1,164 - a year's support to a regional resource centre in Ghana, which helps all the groups in the region
